





Culture, which is one of the elements that emerged with the existence of human beings, is a concept that combines all the material and spiritual elements of a society in general. In our project, Turkey, Azerbaijan, Portugal and Lithuania, including a total of 8 schools and 10 teachers from 4 different countries, there are approximately 90 students.
